Company Programme provides a real-life learning opportunity that introduces young people to the world of work as they set up and run their own student company.

Supported by £10m Product and Public Liability insurance, they make all major decisions from sourcing start up capital to choosing director roles, launching a product or service and managing their company finances.

As part of the programme, young people can open a student company business current account with Equals Money, and sell to the public at in person events and our online store, YE Trading Station.

- Flexible duration from 12 weeks up to one academic year

Step-by-step tasks, activities and resources are available on our dedicated platform, Company Connect, where young people manage their company profile together.

Subject to availability, a YE business volunteer (with a valid DBS) will be allocated to offer additional support.

Funding may be available for selected groups of young people, especially those who are currently disengaged or facing difficulties to learning, through our Inspiring Futures programme. Please contact your local YE for more information and to check eligibility.
