ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Team Programme is designed to help young people with mild to moderate additional support needs transition from education to independent living and employment.

Supported by £10m Product and Public Liability insurance, young people set up and run a company over an academic year, developing confidence and life skills.

Each young person takes on a job role in the business such as Management, Finance, Marketing, and Sales. With support from educators and a Young Enterprise representative, they gain experience managing money, open an Equals Money business current account, engage with customers, and present to an audience.

KEY FEATURES

- Suitable for 15-19+ year olds (entry level/ level 1 qualifications)
- Flexible duration from 12 weeks up to one academic year
- Printed delivery guide and online resources
- Support and advice from a volunteer
- School contribution of £560 per student company (up to 32 students) for state schools, or £2,500 for independent schools (multi-buy discounts available)



DELIVERY GUIDE/WEBSITE

To run the programme, educators are provided with the Team Programme delivery guide with adaptable resources. This allows you to choose resources which are appropriate for your students.

Educators will also receive login details to our dedicated website, Company Connect, which provides guidance for you and your students, and access to our monthly competitions.
