

YE's 2017-18 Secondary engagement in the 30% most deprived areas (visual map)

YE has engaged with 39% of secondary Schools across regions in England and Wales. This is an increase of 5% from 2016-17 in the 30% most deprived areas.

The heat map on the left illustrates all secondary schools in the 30% most deprived areas. The red illustrates a high concentration of schools located in the 30% most deprived areas. There is a high concentration of schools in the 30% most deprived areas in London, East Midlands and the Yorkshire & Humber area. The lowest concentration by comparison is in North Wales and the East of England.

The heat map on the right is much like the map on the left but includes schools YE has engaged with illustrated using black dots. In line with the heat spots, YE's highest engagement are concentrated in the areas with the highest intensity in the aforementioned areas and the lowest noticeably in Wales.
