Following the course, students will be equipped to showcase their skills and experience in the very best way to create an 'employable me'.


YE Learning Zone is home to Young Enterprise's online courses for students. This course will equip students with the skills and knowledge needed to navigate the world of work.

Unit two focuses on different jobs and industries. Students will hear from our experts about what working in different industries is actually like, how to get into different jobs within these, and the skills they need to succeed.


Unit 3

Unit 5: Digital Footprints Matter


